## **Drawing Portraits with Hetty Easter**

### **Supply List**

An assortment of generals charcoal pencils -extra soft, soft, medium, hard

Sharpener or knife and sanding block

Vine charcoal

Blending tools-get a variety pack of different sizes-it's the most economical

Viva paper towels (my preferred brand but you can use anything)

Kneaded eraser or two

Chamois (the thickest one you can find from an auto supply store- you can cut smaller pieces)

A large drawing board with clips

Baby wipes to clean your hands

Paper: You can choose a variety from the list below but make sure you have a couple of sheets of the Canson paper.

- Canson Mi-teintes paper is a good basic paper, get 4-6 sheets of a white or cream, your preference.
- If you don't like any texture, find a paper with less texture but with a vellum surface. Rives makes a nice printmaking paper
- If you have some experience and would like a smoother surface and thicker paper- try a sheet of Strathmore 500 vellum series 2or 3 ply
