

## **Family Projects: Tissue Paper Flowers**



## Supplies: Tissue paper (one or multiple colors) and pipe cleaners, twist ties, or tape

Step one: Cut the tissue paper into 6-12 equal-sized squares; bigger squares make bigger flowers
Step two: Layer the tissue paper in a stack
Step three: Fold the stack of tissue paper zig-zag/accordion style
Step four: Secure the folded tissue paper at the middle with a pipe cleaner, tape, or twist tie
Step five: Carefully pull each layer of tissue paper upward one at a time
Step six: Place in a vase or string together to make a garland!
