- 2. "Kneaded eraser" (also known as a "gum eraser" and usually blueish-gray, square and squishy-soft)
- 3. Sketch pad (any that lay flat, spiral may be best for this purpose, book bound is not ideal)
- 4. "UniBall" or "Bic" black pen (permanent and does not smear) and sharpies- ultra fine and regular
- 5. Basic set of Crayola" or fancy "Prismacolor" colored pencils set plus white and black (ROYGBP, BLK and WH or fancy pencils in R, O, Y, BLK and WH)
- 6. "Pink pearl eraser" (with angled tips and pink)
- 7. "Smudge stick" (for shading and blending)
- * 8. Tracing paper- small pad to work on top of students drawings.
- * 9. Mixed media paper/ drawing paper 18 x 24 (I can cut smaller. 2 sheets per person each.
- * 10. One box Vine charcoal
- * 11. Rulers/ hand-held sharpeners
