

VOLTRON SUPPLIES:

– Sewing machine and all stuff that goes with sewing: scissors, cutting wheel, cutting mat, marking pens/chalk, pins for pinning pieces together and for putting onto design wall

Spray Starch

– Quilting rulers: 12” square (for cutting triangles) and 4” x 14”-18” or 6.5” x 24” (for cutting strips from yardage).
– A piece of batting or white flannel to cover design wall (6’x8’)



– Fabric: All full width of fabric
¼ to ½ yards of 14 different fabrics (minimum – bring lots of colors) selvage to selvage (we will be cutting WOF strips):
3 very light (neutral grays or beiges or white or very pale pastels)
3 or more medium lights (pastels)
3 or more medium (brights)
3 dark (dark brown or dark maroon or navy etc)
Black
White

Other options for fabric selection:

Monochromatic palette:

8-12 fabrics of a single hue in as many values as you can find.

Required is a very very light and a very very dark. It is value that makes this quilt interesting so keep that in mind.



OR use only two high contrast colors. Black and White (or other high contrast fabrics): 3 yds each
