

Supply List:

- a copy of *Floral Abundance Quilt: 9 Blocks Plus Borders, Bonus Pillow Instructions* by Deborah Kemball (available from Amazon). **Please purchase in plenty of time before the class so that you can study the blocks and decide which one(s) you want to make.**
- heavy duty freezer paper, *available for purchase in class*
- enough silk or cotton fabric for the block(s) you plan to make.
- 100 weight silk or polyester thread- colors to match your appliqué - optional
- appliqué needles
- embroidery needles
- small craft iron
- portable iron surface (as firm as possible)
- small fabric scissors (preferably serrated)
- paper scissors
- various beads
- ***fine line*** water erasable marker (NOT disappearing), *available for purchase in class*
- sharp pencil (preferably a mechanical one)
- liquid glue baste (like Roxanne's) and sizing (not starch) if you are appliquing with cotton
- Karen Kay Buckley's "Perfect Circles" and "Perfect Ovals" (optional)
- If you have a light box, please bring it and be willing to share it.
- the usual sewing supplies
