

Tools/materials for students to bring

- Big needle nose pliers (the kind from the hardware store, not the small jewelry making ones)
- Wire snips
- Scissors
- Three to four 8-meter spools of embroidery floss
- Several yards of fabric cut into 1.5"-2.5" strips. The exact width isn't super important, in general if you're using thicker/stiffer fabric cut it into slightly thinner strips. Using a rotary cutter and cutting mat is much faster than scissors if you have them. If you're using old clothing or bedsheets, please cut out all zippers, buttons, and tags (seams are fine).
- 25' of rope in a color/textured/material you like
- Yarn, rope, wool, paint, air-drying clay, beads, branches, or whatever other materials and/or found objects you'd like to try incorporating into your sculptural weaving.
